
Be Safe This Summer!

Never take a barbecue grill or stove inside a tent, or caravan, to cook or use as a heat source.



Portable and disposable barbecues, including stoves with a flame, can be dangerous even when cooling or smouldering. They emit large quantities of carbon monoxide (CO) which is a lethal gas that can kill within a few minutes.



Carbon Monoxide

You cannot see it, smell it or taste it!





If you suspect carbon monoxide, call 112 or the emergency services in your country IMMEDIATELY.











Barbecue grills and stoves can be very dangerous!

Only cook in an open and ventilated part of the field or garden.

Make sure that you cook a safe distance away from your tent or caravan.
