## New EU rules cut boilers' appetite for energy

As of tomorrow, 26 September, the energy efficiency of water and space heaters (such as boilers) will be improved due to the entry into force of EU-wide energy efficiency requirements for these products<sup>1</sup>. Buying energy-thrifty boilers will be made easier for consumers because of supporting EU energy label rules.

Stephen Russell, Secretary-General of ANEC, the European consumer voice in standardisation, said:

"Europe sees some of the highest prices for domestic electricity and gas supplies. ANEC welcomes that these new requirements will lead to more efficient products and help preserve increasingly scarce resources."
